Minutes:

Minutes from the March meeting were reviewed and accepted.

Treasurer Report:

Paige Parker reviewed current financial information including a breakdown of expenses as well as money collected for each team. The board discussed problems that have resulted from checks that have been returned for insufficient funds. A motion was made by Mischelle Henson and seconded by Chris Hamby to accept a clause stating that after a person has had one returned check, all future payments from that party must be made in cash.

Old Business:

- Jeff Addison reported that the first aid kits should be available this month.
- The board confirmed that team managers are responsible for maintaining the parent, player, and coach code of conduct signature sheets.
- The need for a soccer complex was discussed. At this time no new information was available in regard to the North Drive baseball complexes possible conversion into soccer fields. Privately owned or donated land was also mentioned; however, at this time no viable options are available.

New Business:

- Tony Henson discussed the need to purchase one set of goals for the Ambush Soccer Association (ASA). Tony reported that these goals are needed for the upcoming Kickers Klassic tournament and

can be purchased through the local YMCA at a cost of approximately \$900. All board members were in agreement to go ahead with this purchase.

- Chris Hamby brought up the possibility of obtaining field sponsors for the Kickers Klassic tournament as a way to generate additional money for ASA.
- Paige Parker will be working with Trio Signs to create window decals for interested Ambush parents. More information will be available soon.
- Chris Hamby opened a discussion about team formation. He has specific concerns related to children not playing in their age group. Pros and cons were discussed; however, no decision was made.
- Tory Pinson requested that all Ambush teams have their game schedules posted to the Ambush website for field maintenance purposes. All team managers are asked to e-mail a copy of their teams schedule to Mischelle Henson as soon as possible.
