### 2/13/06 Ambush Board Meeting

We had a wonderful Ambush Soccer Association (ASA) board meeting this week. For those of you who were not able to attend I am including a brief overview of what was discussed. If you have any question please let us know.

- Developing a Parent/Player/Coach Code of Conduct was discussed. The board is finalizing this document and hope to have it passed and in place at next months meeting.
- A U17 team is in the works. This team would be open to area high school students and will be a member of ASA.
- Two new coaches were accepted. Gabe Adkins was approved as the U13 boy's coach and Michael Smith was accepted as the U17 boy's coach (if a team is developed).
- Revenue from the previous Kickers Classic Tournaments was reviewed. In the past, the Recreation Department received money from concession sales and entry fees. Any money we made came from t-shirt sales, vendors, photographers, and program advertisements. However, the Recreation Department has now offered to split the entry fee money with ASA.
- A Kickers Classic Committee is now being formed. The committee will consist of last year's members and one parent representative from each team. Please let your team manager know if you are interested in serving on this committee.
- The 6v6 committee is being developed. Tara Bozell and Jimmy Stewart were accepted and will Co-Chair this committee. If you are interested in serving please contact Tony Henson, Tara, or Jimmy.
- Anyone willing to sponsor a 6v6 team can do so for \$125 (cost of the t-shirts),
- Each team will be in charge of their own fundraising.
- The possibility of an Ambush yard sale at Ruff Park was discussed. More information is being gathered.
- It has been decided that ASA will have a flat fee for each player. This fee will include:
  - ◆ Coaches
  - ◆ Two \$400 tournaments
  - ◆ Field maintenance

\*Anything above and beyond these costs would be that teams responsibility (including player cards).
- Player fees will be determined based on a minimum roster size. Any surplus money will be used for ASA program development. Minimum Rosters are as follows:
  - \* U9-U10                    9-player minimum
  - \* U11-U12                11-player minimum
  - \* U13-U17                14-player minimum
- Budget issues were discussed and a request was made that a monthly treasury report be made available to ASA members.
- Concern was expressed about the loss taken at the banquet. Many parents could not attend at the last minute. However, Ambush was still charged for these meals.
