**Board Meeting Minutes

**Call to Order**

President Tony Henson called the Ambush Soccer Association (ASA) Board to order at 6:34 p.m.

Upton announced the Commissioner of Field Maintenance position was still vacant.

**Acceptance of August Minutes**

Motion made by M. Henson to accept the August 13, 2007 minutes; seconded by Joyce. All members present voted aye.

**Treasurer's Report**

Moore reported the Board's beginning and ending balance. President Henson noted two sets of goals were purchased. It was also noted approximately \$1,000 was made from the Fall Futbol Fest.

**Unfinished Business**

- Player/Parent Survey – President Henson indicated the Board discussed posting a survey to see where improvements could be made. Upton indicated she only received questions from President Henson. A deadline of Wednesday, November 21 was set for the Board to email questions to Upton. Upton will then put them together and email them to the Board for review.

**New Business**

- Spring 2008 6 v 6 Game Locations – President Henson indicated most likely the fields at Ruff Park would be unplayable for the spring season. The Board discussed alternate

locations or possibly reseeding the fields. Henson indicated he would call the City's Recreation Superintendent for suggestions.

- North Drive Soccer Field Project – President Henson indicated he feels the City is looking at a major expense project and the fields won't be ready for use for one to two years. Upton indicated this is on the agenda for an update to the Committee of the Whole Thursday.
- Uniform Purchase – President Henson indicated two sets of uniforms were needed. He also suggested purchasing extra sets for use as needed. After discussing sizing and who needed uniforms, Upton made a motion to purchase 46 sets of uniforms; seconded by Addison. This would be two complete sets and 10 extras. There being no further discussion all members present voted aye.
- State Coaching Phase in Plan – Addison indicated all coaches and assistant coaches would be required to get a license by 2009. The Board discussed hosting the sessions to decrease cost and to have the hosting local. Addison is going to look into finding a session for two of the existing coaches to attend to get more information on what this consists of. The Board agreed the coaches should not have to bear the expense of training. This will be discussed at the next meeting.
- Other – M. Henson announced referee classes.

Motion made by Henson; seconded by Moore. All present voted aye. The Board adjourned at 7:39 p.m.
